

Fee regulations - Creative Connection for Communities e.V.

§1 Principle

The basis for these contribution regulations is the association's statutes of February 13th, 2021. These contribution regulations are not part of the statutes. They regulate the membership obligations of the members and can only be changed by the general assembly of the association. Resolutions on changes to the contribution regulations apply from the year following the year in which the resolution was passed.

§2 Resolutions

1. Contribution amount:

The fee for active members is € 30 per year. Supporting members can pay a higher annual membership fee of their own choosing, about which they can provide information in their registration or in an informal communication with a period of 30 days before the next membership fee is due.

2. Payment method:

The fee is paid by direct debit. The members give their consent to this, stating their bank details.

3. Cases of hardship:

In cases of social hardship, an application can be made to change the amount of the contribution and the payment modalities. The board of directors decides on the application after examining the necessary evidence.

4. Due date:

The amounts set are levied at the beginning of the financial year, i.e. on January 1 of the following year in which the resolution was passed. Another date can also be set by resolution of the general meeting. Regarding the beginning of membership during the year, the regulations of the statutes apply.

5. Changes to member data, obligation to notify:

The members are obliged to notify the association of any changes in address and bank account immediately in writing. If changes of address are not communicated or communicated late, the association can claim any lost amounts.

6. Status change:

A status change from active to supporting, and vice versa, can be made after an informal application to the association's board with a notice period of 30 days before the next due date.

7. Default:

In the event of default, the member will be reminded that the fee has not been paid. In the case of reminders, reminder fees of 2,50 euros per reminder are charged. A fee of 3 euros will be charged for returns by direct debit. According to the statutes, failure to pay two membership fees automatically (i.e. without a reminder) is considered a resignation.

§3 Contribution and donation receipt

At the end of a financial year, non-members and members receive a certificate stating that contributions or donations have been made.
